



The Third Minnesota International Piano-e-Competition Announces the Order of Performances for its Contestants

The competition rounds for the third Minnesota International Piano-e-Competition will take place between July 3-14, 2006 at Sundin Hall, Hamline University in St. Paul and Orchestra Hall in Minneapolis. All rounds will be open to the public and videostreamed live over the internet. Audition recitals and final round performances will also be available for the general public to download as MIDI files on their own computers or on their own Disklavier pianos from the e-competition home page.

The Piano-e-Competition brings together twenty-four young pianists from fourteen countries—who have been chosen from 132 initial applicants—to compete for a top prize of \$25,000, a CD recording issued on the Ten Thousand Lakes label, a Yamaha DC3M4 Pro 6' 1" Disklavier Grand piano, and an international recital tour.
